GENERAL TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Salesianum is located at 1801 North Broom Street, Wilmington, DE 19802-2891, directly across from the beautiful Brandywine Park. Situated just a few blocks from the intersection of I-95 and Route 202, Salesianum is convenient to students living in Delaware, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Maryland. Students arrive at Salesianum by school bus, public transportation, car pool, van pool and individual cars. Bus service is available from many parts of New Castle County, Middletown, Smyrna, Dover, Chester County, PA; and New Jersey.

1. Delaware Residents

A. School Bus

In an effort to keep transportation costs as low as possible, Salesianum contracts shared buses with Ursuline and Padua. These buses transport students in Hockessin, Newark, Glasgow, and Dover and New Castle County. This year, all bus fares will be reduced to \$1000 for each bus. Salesianum subsidizes well over 50% of the cost for all students. Most of the stops are, "hub stops," rather than private stops, so some families arrange carpools to the hub stops. Please email Transportation Coordinator Matt Kegelmann of any changes in transportation status. There is an August 15 deadline for dropping a bus with no further fee (although the deposit is nonrefundable) and to be eligible for the State subsidy payment.

B. DART Bus

DART schedules and routes can be found at www.dartfirststate.com In addition to being less expensive than the school bus, DART riders have more options for departure times.

C. Parent Subsidy

The State of Delaware is not providing a subsidy this year.

D. Carpools

Please note: Families who move to Delaware after having completed and submitted the Transportation Contract you must notify Mr. Kegelma via email at mkegelma@salesianum.org, by August 30th in order to be eligible for a State of Delaware Subsidy payment.

3. New Jersey Residents

The State of New Jersey provides no financial or transportation services to its residents. Salesianum contracts a bus from Lehanes Bus Service. The cost is \$1000 per student, reflecting Salesianum's 50% contribution to bussing costs.

4. Maryland Residents

Maryland students can pick up the Newark bus from Christ the Teacher school.
